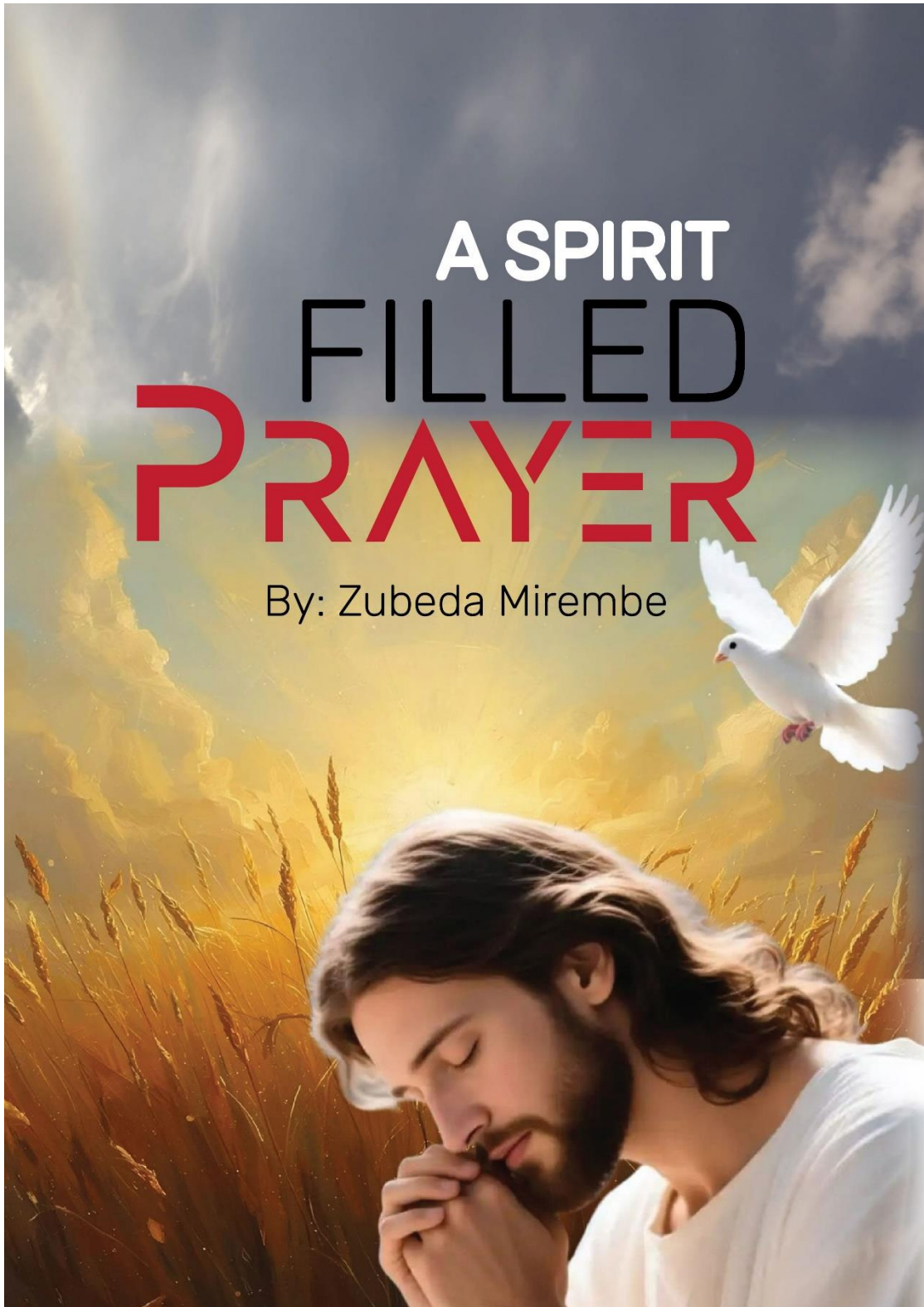


# A SPIRIT FILLED PRAYER

## INTRODUCTION

### **Knowing Jesus and the salvation plan of God.**

God created man in his own image and gave him dominion over the earth to subdue and to take care of it. However, man disobeyed God and fell; In the Garden of Eden. Therefore, was separated from God and His presence. (Genesis 1:26)

So, to restore man, God had to send someone to deliver him and restore him back to himself. And who better than himself. His word, Jesus, coming forth from God. A holy one to save the broken. Therefore, the relation between man and God was restored by the dying of Jesus; by taking away their sins and making them clean once more again. So who God loved could not be destroyed by death anymore by going to hell.

Because the wages of sin is death. And therefore, would have to die, so Jesus died in your place that you might have life and live.

### **The Image of God /The trinity**

Then God said, "Let us make mankind in our image, in our likeness, so that they may rule over the fish in the sea and the birds in the sky, over the livestock and all the wild animals, and over all the creatures that move along the ground."

God is three in one, so man was made in God's image of three in one; because God works in unity. So man is also united within his soul, body and spirit.

"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it." (John 1:1-4)

God works in unison, in oneness, His personality is spirit, the word and the holy spirit, and each is a personality. The word also known as the light, in John 1; the light who came to be Jesus and now the son of God in the flesh, but still God.

And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth. (John 1:14)

### **Jesus;**

Why did Jesus have to become a man you say!

Well as God's word does not fall onto the ground, but has to accomplish its purpose. Genesis 2:17 - man had to die if he had eaten of the fruit of the tree of knowledge of good and evil. And we all know God's word cannot go back to him void. Isaiah 55:10-11.

But because God loved man as his greatest creation; created in His own image: man was part of God and therefore God could not destroy him. Therefore God made a plan to save man.

Jesus had to therefore become a man; so then he can die in his place and take the penalty of death on himself. And the word of God would therefore be fulfilled. "By man dying". Think of a parent surrendering himself to die in his child's stead after the child has messed up in life. And therefore in that regard the child could live.

In this manner that's why man needed a saviour to save him from sin and death. And Jesus came as his saviour, to save him from death by dying in His place; taking the payment of death. By His blood, man was redeemed from the death penalty that he was supposed to take. His blood cleansing us from our sins: A holy blood in exchange for a corrupted blood.

High priest - Jesus became our high priest by making an offering of his blood to God for our sake, that we can be cleansed from our transgressions.

We see that without the shedding of blood; there's no remission of sin. Hebrews. And that's why the high priest had to make an offering to God for the removal of sin on one person.

Why blood offering! We see in how God created his creation; He put life in the blood. Blood is the life of an individual. And when blood is corrupted, there's therefore no more life in it and the person has to die and it needs to be replaced. This we see in trying to diffuse blood to save a life, or methods like chemotherapy, replacing blood; because death of someone will occur if blood is not clean.

So, in a way sin also corrupts us. And when sin entered man, our blood was therefore corrupted and we needed new blood to live in so we can have life again. So Jesus made that exchange by giving us his new blood so we can have life again.

And not any other blood, but a holy blood had to be made, because God is holy. To clean us and make us holy again, because In him there's no sin And His dwelling place is holy. So To enter heaven - man has to be holy.

So, he took our sin on the cross and gave us his holiness so we can enter back and be reconciled to God. And our relationship was therefore restored.

By accepting/confessing Jesus Christ in our life and confessing he died for us we accept the payment he made for us and his cleansing blood to clean us and restore us back to God.

Why if he already died for man.

Because God does not force. He loves you so much and sent this payment for you, and save you by entering into his kingdom in heaven. But it has to be by your own free will to accept it.

God is not a dictator that he should force us to do anything; so it has to be by your free will. He has put free will in man.

He is holy and a just God. So has refrained himself from controlling man's decisions, but he can help man and by doing this, by teaching us. Through Jesus. That's why he had to teach us his ways and lead us in his ways and paths through Jesus.

And when Jesus left, he still had to help us to teach us more about him by leaving us with the holy spirit. John 14:26- reflecting more on God's love and how he will not leave us alone and comfortless. But be with us always.

Without man knowing God's ways, he keeps falling and being misled. And that's why Jesus had to come and teach us to lead us, and lead us into God's paths and tell us more about the ways of God and tell us more about God. So God helps us in many ways and is always with us, by our side; directing us in the right ways and in the right paths.

But the decision to accept him and His love comes from man himself. Because two cannot walk together unless they agree. (Amos 3:3)

And Jesus is our savior and our salvation to lead us back to God.

How do we know He is the savior and the right one who saved us!

God first tells us about him and the coming messiah who will reconcile us back to God.

(Amos 3:7) Surely the Lord God will do nothing but, he reveals his secret to his servants the prophets.

We see part of these prophecies from God to his servants. Such as in the book of Isaiah 53,

### How do we know this!

By God telling us this in the book of Zechariah the prophet. (Zechariah 2:10-12)

Sing and rejoice, O daughter of Zion: for, lo, I come, and I will dwell in

the midst of thee, saith the LORD.

And many nations shall be joined to the LORD in that day, and shall be my people: and I will dwell in the midst of you, and you shall know that the LORD of hosts has sent me to you.

And the LORD shall inherit Judah his portion in the holy land, and shall choose Jerusalem again. Be silent, O all flesh, before the LORD: for he is raised up out of his holy habitation.

Can God come into his creation ! YES;

Of course He can; because he created his creation to be good.

Because he is good and a perfect God and all that comes from him is part of him and good. We see this Genesis 1, John 1

And God saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, it was very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day.

So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. (Genesis 2:31)

Man is very special to God because he created him in his own image.

So when God looks at his creation, He sees that it is Good. Man from his image, and all his creation from his perfection. (Genesis 2:27)

In this we see that it is not only possible, but God is delighted to be part of his creation, and walk with his people and be part of them as was his purpose from the beginning before man fell.

God would come and visit man(Adam) everyday in the garden and spend time with him. In the cool of the day, as in Genesis 8.

And this is the purpose when we are reconciled with him and live with him forever together with him in heaven. And at the end of the world when sin shall finally be destroyed and the devil cast into eternal hell/lake of fire.

### **A sign;**

God sends a sign of Knowing who the Savior will be.

This is to make his people know and lead them away from any

deception that might come their way by the devil again to deceive them from accepting him.

Isaiah 7:14 - Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.

Matthew 1:18-23

Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost.

Then Joseph her husband, being a just man, and not willing to make her a public example, was minded to put her away privately.

But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost.

- And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name **JESUS**: for he shall save his people from their sins.

### **Mary Chosen to bear Jesus;**

Now all this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying,

Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, **God with us.**

Now in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of

David. The virgin's name was Mary. And having come in, the angel said to her, "Rejoice, highly favored one, the Lord is with you; blessed are you among women!"

But when she saw *him*, she was troubled at his saying, and considered

what manner of greeting this was. Then the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name **JESUS.**

He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end."

Then Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I do not know a man?"

And the angel answered and said to her, "*The* Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God.

Now indeed, Elizabeth your relative has also conceived a son in her old age; and this is now the sixth month for her who was called barren. **For with God nothing will be impossible.**"

Then Mary said, "Behold the maidservant of the Lord! Let it be to me according to your word." And the angel departed from her.

**Born of the will of God - Therefore Jesus becomes the son of God.**

We also see this in, John 1: 12-13 to be born of the spirit of God and becoming a son of God.

**How is this possible?** Because these are God's ways. His ways are not our ways. (Isaiah 55:8-9). And His ways are to make us such as his children. God works within the family perspective, just as he has given to man.

**For with God nothing shall be impossible."** Luke 1:37

## **Glory to God in the Highest – Luke 2:8-20**

Now there were in the same country shepherds living out in the fields, keeping watch over their flock by night. And behold, an angel of the Lord stood before them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were greatly afraid. Then the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid, for behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people. For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. And this *will* be the sign to you: You will find a Babe wrapped in swaddling cloths, lying in a manger."

And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying:

"Glory to God in the highest,  
And on earth peace, goodwill toward men!"

So it was, when the angels had gone away from them into heaven, that the shepherds said to one another, "Let us now go to Bethlehem and see this thing that has come to pass, which the Lord has made known to us." And they came with haste and found Mary and Joseph, and the Babe lying in a manger. Now when they had seen *Him*, they made widely known the saying which was told them concerning this Child. And all those who heard *it* marveled at those things which were told them by the shepherds. But Mary kept all these things and pondered *them* in her heart. Then the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things that they had heard and seen, as it was told them.

### **HOW JESUS COMES INTO THE WORLD:**

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.

### **John Witness: The True Light (John 6:13)**

There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. This man came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all through him might believe. He was not that Light, but was sent to bear witness of that Light. That was the true Light which gives light to every man coming into the world.

He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him. He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him. But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

### **BECOMES FLESH**

And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

John bore witness of Him and cried out, saying, "This was He of whom I said, 'He who comes after me is preferred before me, for He was before me.' "

And of His fullness we have all received, and grace for grace. For the law was given through Moses, *but* grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. No one has seen God at any time. The only begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has declared *Him*.

## **John sent to bear witness of his and to baptize Him.**

(Luke 1:5-25)

There was in the days of Herod, the king of Judea, a certain priest named Zacharias, of the division of Abijah. His wife was of the daughters of Aaron, and her name was

Elizabeth. And they were both righteous before God, walking in all the commandments and ordinances of the Lord blameless. But they had no child, because Elizabeth was

barren, and they were both well advanced in years.

So it was, that while he was serving as priest before God in the order of his division,

according to the custom of the priesthood, his lot fell to burn incense when he went into the temple of the Lord. And the whole multitude of the people was praying outside at

the hour of incense. Then an angel of the Lord appeared to him, standing on the right

side of the altar of incense. And when Zacharias saw *him*, he was troubled, and fear fell upon him.

But the angel said to him, "Do not be afraid, Zacharias, for your prayer is heard; and your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you shall call his name John. And you will have joy and gladness, and many will rejoice at his birth. For he will be great in the sight of

the Lord, and shall drink neither wine nor strong drink. He will also be filled with the Holy Spirit, even from his mother's womb. And he will turn many of the children of Israel to

the Lord their God. He will also go before Him in the spirit and power of Elijah, 'to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children,' and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just, to make ready a people prepared for the Lord."

And Zacharias said to the angel, "How shall I know this? For I am an old man, and my wife is well advanced in years."

And the angel answered and said to him, "I am Gabriel, who stands in the presence of God, and was sent to speak to you and bring you

these glad tidings. But behold, you will be mute and not able to speak until the day these things take place, because you did not believe my words which will be fulfilled in their own time."

And the people waited for Zacharias, and marveled that he lingered so long in the temple. But when he came out, he could not speak to them; and they perceived that he had seen a vision in the temple, for he beckoned to them and remained speechless.

So it was, as soon as the days of his service were completed, that he departed to his own house. Now after those days his wife Elizabeth conceived; and she hid herself five months, saying, "Thus the Lord has dealt with me, in the days when He looked on *me*, to take away my reproach among people."

John filled with the Holy spirit from the womb - Luke 1:39

Now Mary arose in those days and went into the hill country with haste, to a city of Judah, and entered the house of Zacharias and greeted Elizabeth. And it happened, when Elizabeth heard the greeting of Mary, that the babe leaped in her womb; and Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit. Then she spoke out with a loud voice and said, "Blessed *are* you among women, and blessed *is* the fruit of your womb! But *why is this granted* to me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me? For indeed, as soon as the voice of your greeting sounded in my ears, the babe leaped in my womb for joy.

Blessed *is* she who believed, for there will be a fulfillment of those things which were told her from the Lord."

**John, A Voice in the Wilderness - Preparing the way for Jesus** - John 1:19-23

Now this is the testimony of John, when the Jews sent priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask him, "Who are you?"

He confessed, and did not deny, but confessed, "I am not the Christ." And they asked him, "What then? Are you Elijah?" He said, "I am not."



"Are you the Prophet?" And he answered, "No."

Then they said to him, "Who are you, that we may give an answer to those who sent us?"

What do you say about yourself?" He said: "I am

'The voice of one crying in the wilderness:

"Make straight the way of the LORD," ' as the prophet Isaiah said."

## **Now;**

All God's prophecies and promises were fulfilled

So, as we see, God had planned out everything and to the last detail. To inform men and let them know of his salvation coming to them and how he will bring redemption and peace back to all men through Jesus.

## **Peace I leave with you. John 14:26-27**

But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world gives, do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

Jesus brings peace and restores.

Why is the world bad still broken?

The world is still broken because they choose to reject Jesus still and going in their own path of sin This is because we still live in the fallen world

Be sober, be vigilant, because your adversary the devil walketh about as a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour. (1 Peter 5:8). The

devil moves around like a roaring lion seeking to bring evil and people and to cause them into destruction

So, the devil still works hard to stumble people to make them fall and deny Jesus. Because he seeks to destroy man that God loves.

But Jesus gives us confidence and assurance that we will overcome because he has overcome the world. And therefore we will overcome the world too. John 16:33;

These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world." (John 16:33)

### **Jesus the Messiah;**

The woman said to Him, "I know that Messiah is coming" (who is called Christ). "When He comes, He will tell us all things."

Jesus said to her, "I who speak to you am *He*." John4:25-26

"I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep.

I am the good shepherd; and I know My *sheep*, and am known by My own. As the Father knows Me, even so I know the Father; and I lay down My life for the sheep. And other sheep I have which are not of this fold; them also I must bring, and they will hear My voice; and there will be one flock *and* one shepherd.

"Therefore, My Father loves Me, because I lay down My life that I may take it again. No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This command I have received from My Father."

Jesus answered them, "I told you, and you do not believe. The works that I do in My Father's name, they bear witness of Me. But you do not believe, because you are not of My sheep, as I said to you. My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch

them out of My hand. My Father, who has given *them* to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch *them* out of My Father's hand. I and My Father are one." (John 10:11,14-18,25-30 )

In that day you will ask in My name, and I do not say to you that I shall pray the Father for you; for the Father Himself loves you, because you have loved Me, and have believed that I came forth from God. I came forth from the Father and have come into the world. Again, I leave the world and go to the Father." John 16:26-28

John 14:1-6 - Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me.

In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

And where I go you know, and the way you know.

Thomas said to him, Lord, we know not where you are going; and how can we know the way?

Jesus said unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man comes unto the Father, but by me.

### **John 14:7-31**

"If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; and from now on you know Him and have seen Him."

Philip said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is sufficient for us."

Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the

Father'? Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own *authority*; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works. 11 Believe Me that I

*am* in the Father and the Father in Me, or else believe Me for the sake of the works themselves.

“Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater *works* than these he will do, because I go to My Father. And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask anything in My name, I will do *it*.

“If you love Me, keep My commandments. And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever; Even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you. I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you.

“A little while longer and the world will see Me no more, but you will see Me. Because I live, you will live also. At that day you will know that I *am* in My Father, and you in Me, and I in you. He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him.”

Judas (not Iscariot) said to Him, “Lord, how is it that You will manifest Yourself to us, and not to the world?”

Jesus answered and said to him, “If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him. He who does not love Me does not keep My words; and the word which you hear is not Mine but the Father's who sent Me.

“These things I have spoken to you while being present with you. But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you. Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid. You have heard Me say to you, ‘I am going away and

coming back to you.' If you loved Me, you would rejoice because I said, 'I am going to the Father,' for My Father is greater than I.

"And now I have told you before it comes, that when it does come to pass, you may believe. I will no longer talk much with you, for the ruler of this world is coming, and he has nothing in Me. But that the world may know that I love the Father, and as the Father gave Me commandment, so I do. Arise, let us go from here.

### **John 10, More knowledge about Jesus;**

Philip said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is sufficient for us."

Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'?"

Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own *authority*; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works. Believe Me that I *am* in the Father and the Father in Me, or else believe Me for the sake of the works themselves.

### **Works,**

Show me Your ways, O LORD; Teach me Your paths. Lead me in Your truth and teach me, For You are the God of my salvation; On You I wait all the day.  
Remember, O LORD, Your tender mercies and Your loving kindnesses, For they are of old. (Psalm 25:4-6)

Have mercy upon me, O God, According to Your lovingkindness; According to the multitude of Your tender mercies,

The LORD on high is mightier than the noise of many waters, yea, than the mighty waves of the sea. Your testimonies are very sure: holiness

becomes your house, O LORD, forever.

(Psalm 93 : 3-5)

O God, be not far from me: O my God, make haste for my help.

(Psalm 71:12)

Deliver me, O my God, out of the hand of the wicked, out of the hand of the unrighteous and cruel man.

For you are my hope, O Lord God: you are my trust.

(Psalm 71:1-5)

For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but the Lord shall arise upon us, and his glory shall be seen upon us. (Isaiah 60:2) They that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.(Isaiah 40:31)

No weapon that is formed against me shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against me in judgment I shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness is of me, says the LORD. (Isaiah 54:17)

The fierce anger of the Lord shall not return, until he has done it, and until he have performed the intents of his heart: (Jeremiah 30:23-24)

When I pass through the waters, He will be with me;

And through the rivers, they shall not overflow me. When I walk through the fire, I shall not be burned, Nor shall the flame scorch me.

For you're the Lord my God,

The Holy One of Israel, my Savior; (Isaiah 43:2-3)

Behold, God is my salvation; I will trust, and not be afraid: for the Lord Jehovah is my strength and my song; he also is become my salvation. (Isaiah 12:2)

God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. (Psalm 46:1)

You have beset me behind and before, and laid your hand upon me. (Psalm 139:5)

For I am dead and my life is hidden in Christ Jesus, in God. (Colossians 3:3)

For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. (Romans 10:13)

I will praise you, O LORD, with my whole heart; I will show forth all your marvelous works. I will be glad and rejoice in thee: I will sing praise to your name, O thou most High.

When my enemies are turned back, they shall fall and perish at your presence.

(Psalm 9 : 1-3)

O LORD, our Lord, how excellent is your name in all the earth! who has set your glory above the heavens.

Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings have you ordained strength because of your enemies, that you might still the enemy and the avenger.

(Psalm 8 : 1-2)

Behold, the LORD's hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear. (Isaiah 59:1)

You go before us, and make the crooked places straight: You break in pieces the gates of brass, and cut in sunder the bars of iron:

And will give us the treasures of darkness, and hidden riches of secret places, that we may know that You, the LORD, which call us by our name, are the God of Israel.(Isaiah 45:2-3)

But you're the LORD our God, that divided the sea, whose waves roared: The LORD of hosts is his name. And you have put your words in my mouth, and have covered me in the shadow of your hand, that you may plant the heavens, and lay the foundations of the earth, and say unto Zion, You are my people.(Isaiah 51:15-16)

We Look unto you, and be saved, all the ends of the earth: for you are God, and there is none else.(Isaiah 45:2-3)

You have graven us upon the palms of your hands; our walls are continually before you.(Isaiah 49:16)

Yet the LORD will command his lovingkindness in the day time, and in the night his song shall be with me, and my prayer unto the God of my life.

(Psalm 42 : 8)

But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

(Isaiah 53:5)

That was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world.

Hear my voice, O God, in my prayer: preserve my life from fear of the enemy. Hide me from the secret counsel of the wicked; from the insurrection of the workers of iniquity:

The righteous shall be glad in the LORD, and shall trust in him; and all the upright in heart shall glory.

(Psalm 64 : 1-2, 10)

Behold, you will make me a new sharp threshing instrument having teeth: I shall thresh the mountains, and beat them small, and shall make the hills as chaff.(Isaiah

41:15)

I shall Fear not; for you are with me: I shall not be dismayed; for you are my God: you will strengthen me; yes, you will help me; yea, you will uphold mee with the right hand of your righteousness.

Behold, all they that were incensed against me shall be ashamed and confounded: they shall be as nothing; and they that strive with me shall perish.(Isaiah 41:10-11)

O LORD, you are my God; I will exalt you, I will praise your name; for you have done wonderful things; your counsels of old are faithfulness and truth.(Isaiah 25) Deliver me, O Lord, from my enemies: I flee unto you to hide me.

Whosoever believes on you shall not be ashamed.(Romans 10:11)

Give ear to my prayer, O God; and hide not yourself from my supplication. Attend unto me, and hear me: I mourn in my complaint, and make a noise; Because of the voice of the enemy, because of the oppression of the wicked: for they cast iniquity upon me, and in wrath they hate me.

My heart is sore pained within me: and the terrors of death are fallen upon me.

Fearfulness and trembling are come upon me, and horror has

overwhelmed me. And I said, Oh that I had wings like a dove! for then would I fly away, and be at rest.

As for me, I will call upon God; and the Lord shall save me.

I Cast my burdens upon the LORD, and he shall sustain me: he shall never suffer the righteous to be moved.

(Psalm 55 : 1-6, 22)

The heavens declare his righteousness, and all the people see his glory. Confounded be all they that serve graven images, that boast themselves of idols: worship him, all ye gods.

Behold, all they that were incensed against me shall be ashamed and confounded: they shall be as nothing; and they that strive with me shall perish.

I shall seek them, and shall not find them, even them that contended with me: they that war against me shall be as nothing, and as a thing of nought(nothing).

"Fear you not; for I am with you: be not dismayed; for I am your God: I will strengthen you; yea, I will help you; yea, I will uphold you with the right hand of my righteousness."(Isaiah 41:10-12) - Declares the Lord.

Hear my voice, O God, in my prayer: preserve my life from fear of the enemy. Hide me from the secret counsel of the wicked; from the insurrection of the workers of iniquity: The righteous shall be glad in the LORD, and shall trust in him; and all the upright in heart shall glory.

(Psalm 64 : 1-2, 10)

Truly my soul waits upon God: from him comes my salvation. He only is my rock and my salvation; he is my defence; I shall not be greatly moved.

(Psalm 62 : 1-2)

## **The salvation of the Lord;**

The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

When the wicked, even my enemies and my foes, came upon me to eat up my flesh, they stumbled and fell.

One thing have I desired of the Lord, that will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the Lord, and to enquire in his temple.

For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret of his tabernacle shall he hide me; he shall set me up upon a rock.

And now shall my head be lifted up above mine enemies round about me: therefore will I offer in his tabernacle sacrifices of joy; I will sing, yea, I will sing praises unto the Lord.

Hear, O Lord, when I cry with my voice: have mercy also upon me, and answer me. When you said, Seek my face; my heart said unto you, Your face, Lord, will I seek.

Hide not your face far from me; put not your servant away in anger: you have been my help; leave me not, neither forsake me, O God of my salvation.

When my father and my mother forsake me, then the Lord will take me up. Teach me your way, O Lord, and lead me in a plain path, because of mine enemies.

Deliver me not over unto the will of mine enemies: for false witnesses are risen up against me, and such as breathe out cruelty.

I had fainted, unless I had believed to see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living.

Wait on the Lord: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the Lord. (Psalm 27)

I will love thee, O Lord, my strength.

The Lord is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, and my high tower.

I will call upon the Lord, who is worthy to be praised: so shall I be saved from my enemies.

The sorrows of death compassed me, and the floods of ungodly men made me afraid. The sorrows of hell compassed me about: the snares of death prevented me.

In my distress I called upon the Lord, and cried unto my God: he heard my voice out of his temple, and my cry came before him, even into his ears.

Then the earth shook and trembled; the foundations also of the hills moved and were shaken, because he was wroth.

There went up a smoke out of his nostrils, and fire out of his mouth devoured: coals were kindled by it.

He bowed the heavens also, and came down: and darkness was under his feet. And he rode upon a cherub, and did fly: yea, he did fly upon the wings of the wind.

He made darkness his secret place; his pavilion round about him were dark waters and thick clouds of the skies.

At the brightness that was before him his thick clouds passed, hail stones and coals of fire.

The Lord also thundered in the heavens, and the Highest gave his voice; hail stones and coals of fire.

Yea, he sent out his arrows, and scattered them; and he shot out lightnings, and discomfited them.

Then the channels of waters were seen, and the foundations of the world were discovered at thy rebuke, O Lord, at the blast of the breath of thy nostrils.



He sent from above, he took me, he drew me out of many waters.  
He delivered me from my strong enemy, and from them which hated me: for they were too strong for me.

They prevented me in the day of my calamity: but the Lord was my stay.

He brought me forth also into a large place; he delivered me, because he delighted in me.

The Lord rewarded me according to my righteousness; according to the cleanness of my hands has he recompensed me.

For I have kept the ways of the Lord, and have not wickedly departed from my God.

For all his judgments were before me, and I did not put away his statutes from me. I was also upright before him, and I kept myself from my iniquity.

Therefore, hath the Lord recompensed me according to my righteousness, according to the cleanness of my hands in his eyesight.

You alone *are*  
God.

Teach me Your way, O LORD; I will walk in Your truth; Unite my heart to  
fear Your name.

I will praise You, O Lord my God, with all my heart, And I will glorify Your  
name forevermore.

For great *is* Your mercy toward me, And You have delivered my soul  
from the depths of Sheol. O God, the proud have risen against me,  
And a mob of violent *men* have sought my life, And have not set You  
before them.

But You, O Lord, *are* a God full of compassion, and gracious,

Longsuffering and abundant in mercy and truth. Oh, turn to me, and have mercy on me!

Give Your strength to Your servant, And save the son of Your maidservant. Show me a sign for good, That those who hate me may see *it* and be ashamed,

Let them sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving,  
And declare His works with rejoicing. Those who go down to the sea in ships,

I keep Your precepts and Your testimonies, For all my ways *are* before You.

Let my cry come before You, O LORD; Give me understanding according to Your word.

Let my supplication come before You; Deliver me according to Your word. My lips shall utter praise, For You teach me Your statutes. My tongue shall speak of Your word, For all Your commandments *are* righteousness.

Let Your hand become my help, For I have chosen Your precepts.

I long for Your salvation, O LORD, And Your law *is* my delight. Let my soul live, and it shall praise You; And let Your judgments help me. I have gone astray like a lost sheep; Seek Your servant, For I do not forget Your commandments.

## **Psalm 115**

### **John 16 - Jesus final advice and comfort.**

"These things I have spoken to you, that you should not be made to stumble. They will put you out of the synagogues; yes, the time is coming that whoever kills you will think that he offers God service. And these things they will do to you because they have not known the father nor Me. But these things I have told you, that when the time

comes, you may remember that I told you of them.

“And these things I did not say to you at the beginning, because I was with you.

“But now I go away to Him who sent Me, and none of you asks Me, ‘Where are You going?’ But because I have said these things to you, sorrow has filled your heart. Nevertheless, I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you. And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: of sin, because they do not believe in Me; of righteousness, because I go to My Father and you see Me no more; of judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged.

“I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear *them* now. However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own *authority*, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come. He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare *it* to you. All things that the Father has are Mine. Therefore I said that He will take of Mine and declare *it* to you.

Sorrow Will Turn to Joy

“A little while, and you will not see Me; and again a little while, and you will see Me, because I go to the Father.”

Then *some* of His disciples said among themselves, “What is this that He says to us, ‘A little while, and you will not see Me; and again a little while, and you will see Me’; and, ‘because I go to the Father’?” They said therefore, “What is this that He says, ‘A little while’? We do not know what He is saying.”

Now Jesus knew that they desired to ask Him, and He said to them, “Are you inquiring among yourselves about what I said, ‘A little while, and you will not see Me; and again a little while, and you will see Me’?”

Most assuredly, I say to you that you will weep and lament, but the

world will rejoice; and you will be sorrowful, but your sorrow will be turned into joy. A woman, when she is in labor, has sorrow because her hour has come; but as soon as she has given birth to the child, she no longer remembers the anguish, for joy that a human being has been born into the world.

Therefore, you now have sorrow; but I will see you again and your heart will rejoice, and your joy no one will take from you.

“And in that day you will ask Me nothing. Most assuredly, I say to you, whatever you ask the Father in My name He will give you. Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full.

“These things I have spoken to you in proverbs ; but the time is coming when I will no longer speak to you in figurative language, but I will tell you plainly about the Father. In that day you will ask in My name, and I do not say to you that I shall pray the Father for you; for the Father Himself loves you, because you have loved Me, and have believed that I came forth from God.

I came forth from the Father and have come into the world. Again, I leave the world and go to the Father.”

His disciples said to Him, “See, now You are speaking plainly, and using no figure of speech! Now we are sure that You know all things, and have no need that anyone should question You. By this we believe that You came forth from God.”

Jesus answered them, “Do you now believe? Indeed the hour is coming, yes, has now come, that you will be scattered, each to his own, and will leave Me alone.

And yet I am not alone, because the Father is with Me. These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.”

**Jesus' final prayer for believers. (John 17)**  
**(Prayer for us)**

Jesus spoke these words, lifted up His eyes to heaven, and said: "Father, the hour has come. Glorify Your Son, that Your Son also may glorify You, as You have given Him authority over all flesh, that He should give eternal life to as many as You have given Him. And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent. I have glorified You on the earth. I have finished the work which You have given Me to do. And now, O Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was.

**Jesus Prays for His Disciples**

"I have manifested Your name to the men whom You have given Me out of the world. They were Yours, You gave them to Me, and they have kept Your word. Now they have known that all things which You have given Me are from You. For I have given to them the words which You have given Me; and they have received *them*, and have known surely that I came forth from You; and they have believed that You sent Me.

"I pray for them. I do not pray for the world but for those whom You have given Me, for they are Yours. And all Mine are Yours, and Yours are Mine, and I am glorified in them. Now I am no longer in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to You. Holy Father, keep through Your name those whom You have given Me, that they may be one as We are. While I was with them in the world, I kept them in Your name. Those whom You gave Me I have kept; and none of them is lost except the son of perdition, that the Scripture might be fulfilled. But now I come to You, and these things I speak in the world, that they may have My joy fulfilled in themselves.

I have given them Your word; and the world has hated them because they are not of the world, just as I am not of the world.

I do not pray that You should take them out of the world, but that You should keep them from the evil one. They are not of the world, just as I am not of the

world. Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth. As You sent Me into the world, I also have sent them into the world. And for their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they also may be sanctified by the truth.

### **Jesus Prays for All Believers**

“I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word; that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me. And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one: I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in one, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me.

“Father, I desire that they also whom You gave Me may be with Me where I am, that they may behold My glory which You have given Me; for You loved Me before the foundation of the world. O righteous Father! The world has not known You, but I have known You; and these have known that You sent Me.

And I have declared to them Your name, and will declare *it*, that the love with which You loved Me may be in them, and I in them.”
